## Standards of Behavior

1. All CYC members are expected to display a Christ-like attitude at all times. They shall:

- a. Respect the authority of Counselors
- b. Be cooperative
- c. Attend and participate in all classes and activities
- d. Obey camp and conference rules and respect curfew
- e. Remain within the camp boundaries at all times
- f. Perform assigned duties
- g. Leave cabins and camp clean at end of conference

2. All clothing worn at YOC functions should show respect for God, ourselves and others. Proper meeting attire should be worn on Sunday morning

3. Baptized members should be an example to unbaptized members

4. Smoking, use of drugs or alcohol, stealing, bad language and other disrespectful behavior will not be tolerated. Radios, CD players (MP3 players etc) and electronic games shall be left at home.

Consequences for infractions shall be from among the following:

- a. Warning;
- b. assignment of a chore;
- c. assign a counselor to watch the offender;
- d. public apology; call parents and ask them to remove the offender from the conference.

## **Duties of the Counselors**

1. Counselors shall attend all YOC meetings and functions. They shall be available for help with problems and for spiritual guidance.

2. Both a male and a female counselor shall be provided by each Ecclesia at all conferences.

3. At least one counselor shall reside in each cabin at all conferences

4. Counselors shall be available when needed to:

- a. Assist with problems
- b. Listen with an understanding attitude
- c. Be a substitute parent
- d. Be alert both in and out of the cabin
- e. Enforce rules when necessary
- f. Be an example to CYC members

5. Counselors shall meet at the beginning of each conference to review the rules and make specific camp rules as needed (camp boundaries etc)

6. Universal authority shall be given to all Counselors at all YOC events

7. Counselors shall introduce themselves to the CYC members at the beginning of each conference.
